Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- move, pack and load production equipment under instruction for at least two productions
- use safe manual-handling techniques when moving physical elements
- work collaboratively.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided for each of the above points at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements the individual must:

- describe procedures and processes for bumping in and bumping out different types of productions
- describe physical elements used for different types of productions and typical locations for them in production venues
- describe the roles and responsibilities of personnel involved in the bump in and bump out process
- explain how safe manual-handling techniques apply to the movement of physical elements
- describe packing materials and techniques used for different types of equipment
- describe techniques for loading and stowing equipment for safe transportation
- describe the range of tools commonly required during the bump in and bump out process.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in creative arts industry environments. The assessment environment must include access to:

- a venue or location for bump in and bump out
- transport vehicles into which physical elements can be loaded.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational educational and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
