Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the DEF Defence Training Package.

Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to prepare for implementation of Moral Injury Pastoral Narrative Disclosure (PND) with members and their families who may have Moral Injury (MI).

This unit applies to Chaplaincy in Defence, although it would also apply to others who work in this field, including emergency first responders. This includes theology of multi-faith or other belief systems.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Organisational policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.

Those undertaking this unit would work independently and perform complex tasks in a complex environment.

| 4 Provide referrals for Moral Injury support | 4.1 | Identify and prioritise the symptoms and signs displayed by a member which may result in a referral to a health care practitioner(s) |

- 4.2 Collaborate with health care practitioner(s) to help them identify symptoms and signs which may cause them to refer a member to a Chaplain to address their potential Moral Injury
- 4.3 Identify additional support services available
- 4.4 Obtain and record consent from a member and their family before referral to a support service in accordance with organisational procedures
- 4.5 Make referrals that address the needs of the member and their family according to organisational policies and procedures
- 4.6 Obtain feedback from the member and their family on how the PND process assisted them
