Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- configuring basic circuits
- handling classified material correctly
- identifying basic equipment faults
- operating communications equipment
- processing messages
- preparing communication equipment
- complying with WHS/radiation hazard policy
- complying with emission control policy
- maintaining security

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

- basic communications procedures
- basic radio propagation
- classified material handling procedures
- communications ancillary equipment
- composition of teams and roles and responsibilities of team members
- emission theory and control

- information exchange systems terminology and basic operations
- message format
- work health and safety (WHS) practices
- OTAT/OTAR procedures
- radiation hazard(RADHAZ) procedures and awareness
- satellite communications systems terminology and basic operations
- security procedures
- task specific equipment configuration/operation
- work environment layout

Assessment Conditions

Competency should be assessed in an actual workplace or in a simulated environment, with access to equipment and infrastructure appropriate to the outcome. Competency should be demonstrated over time to ensure the candidate is assessed across a variety of situations.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
