Application

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to identify material that is suitable for publication in all forms of media.

It includes identifying sources for potential stories and relevant public affairs objectives, and establishing story points or themes.

This unit applies to Defence public affairs personnel but it could apply to any personnel who work in this field.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Organisational policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.

Persons undertaking this unit work under indirect supervision or as part of a team, and perform specific tasks in familiar contexts.
