## Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the candidate must demonstrate evidence of performance of the following on at least one occasion.

- applying analysis techniques and technologies
- applying safety policies and structures
- using testing tools and equipment
- using PPE
- using manual handling and team lifting techniques
- handling dangerous goods and hazardous substances

## Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence must satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria. If not otherwise specified the depth of knowledge demonstrated must be appropriate to the job context of the candidate.

Operational knowledge of:

- characteristics and limitations of testing equipment
- explosive chemistry
- organisational documentation requirements
- properties and characteristics of explosives
- properties and characteristics of testing chemicals

## Assessment Conditions

Competency should be assessed in an actual workplace or in a simulated environment, with access to equipment and infrastructure appropriate to the outcome. Competency should be demonstrated over time to ensure the candidate is assessed across a variety of situations.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
