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Modification History

Release 1. This is the first release of this unit of competency in the DEF Defence Training Package.

Application

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to provide specialist advice related to the technical regulatory framework.

It includes identifying complex issues, providing technical advice, formulating options and selecting the preferred option to address identified issues. It specifically addresses advice that is relevant to technical regulatory framework activity and is not intended to cover technical advice that is provided in a broader context of the organisational endeavour or a professional discipline.

This unit applies to technical regulatory framework specialists working in Defence materiel logistics but is applicable to any persons in this field of work.

The skills and knowledge described in this unit must be applied within the legislative, regulatory and policy environment in which they are carried out. Organisational policies and procedures must be consulted and adhered to.

Typically, persons undertaking this unit work independently or as part of a team under direct and indirect supervision, use discretion and judgement, and take responsibility for the quality of their outputs.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

PERFORMANCE CRITERIA

Performance criteria describe the performance needed to demonstrate achievement of the element.

- 1.1** Observe, receive and clarify circumstances that require provision of advice relating to the technical regulatory framework
- 1.2** Identify and confirm issues, as required, through consultation with relevant personnel
- 1.3** Analyse circumstances, and interpret and clearly define issue/s in accordance with task requirements
- 1.4** Conduct research related to issue/s and seek advice of relevant personnel to clarify unclear findings
- 1.5** Document research outcomes and feedback received from relevant personnel, in accordance with operational procedures
- 2.1** Identify and evaluate appropriate options related to the provision of advice
- 2.2** Prioritise identified options and make recommendations in accordance with task requirements and regulatory framework
- 3.1** Finalise draft advice and discuss with relevant stakeholders in accordance with organisational policies
- 3.2** Negotiate, document and incorporate stakeholder requirements within proposed advice
- 3.3** Report finalised advice in accordance with ethical and practical guidelines and within specified resource constraints
