Application

This unit describes the skills required to provide geospatial technical advice related to geospatial capabilities within a Defence environment. The geospatial capabilities include current and future capability options and are related to current and future Defence operations and training.

This unit was developed for Defence personnel in a geospatial workplace but may be relevant to others who work in this field.

Those undertaking this unit would work independently or as part of a team, under indirect supervision while performing complex tasks, in a small range of familiar contexts. They would use discretion and judgement and take responsibility for the quality of their outputs.

3 Provide advice	3.1 Advice is formulated and discussed with stakeholders in accordance with SOPs 3.2 Stakeholder requirements are negotiated, incorporated and documented within the proposed advice in accordance with SOPs 3.3 Reports are prepared for concluded advice within specified time and budget in accordance with SOPs
