It includes the skills required to analyse proposed training area/range activities, including the management of a booking system, reading and interpreting traces and templates and promulgating activities.

This unit applies to Defence personnel who work in range management and range control but may be relevant to others who work in this field. Those undertaking this unit would work independently, or as part of a team, under indirect supervision, while performing routine tasks, in a variety of different contexts. They would use discretion and judgement and take responsibility for the quality of their outputs.
