Operate and monitor the equipment	2.1 Conduct pre-start checks according to workplace procedures 2.2 Measure and load cleaning agent into dispenser 2.3 Operate equipment and monitor to identify variation in operating conditions 2.4 Report any variation in equipment operation to supervisor 2.5 Shut equipment down safely according to workplace procedures 2.6 Unload washed items, and position in required location 2.7 Keep work area clean and tidy according to health, safety, environmental and food safety procedures 2.8 Clean equipment and complete records, as required by workplace procedures
