#### **Performance Evidence**

An individual demonstrating competency must satisfy all of the elements and performance criteria in this unit.

There must be evidence that the individual has monitored the operation of equipment used in a production process to complete at least one batch or production run, including:

- applying food safety procedures to work practices
- following safe work procedures.

## **Knowledge Evidence**

An individual must be able to demonstrate the knowledge required to perform the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit. This includes knowledge of:

- purpose of equipment used in production process
- required output and quality requirements to be met by the production process
- basic operating principles of equipment used, such as main equipment components, status
  and purpose of guards and emergency stop, isolation and lock-out controls, and, where
  required, the operating features of the control panel and the relationship between control
  panel functions and the physical equipment
- common causes of faults or unacceptable performance, and action required within level of responsibility
- health and safety hazards and controls associated with process operations
- food safety risks associated with process operation, and related control measures
- common contamination and cross-contamination risks associated with the process
- procedures and responsibility for reporting problems arising from monitoring process operations
- recording system and responsibilities for completing records.

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#### **Assessment Conditions**

Assessment of the skills in this unit of competency must take place under the following conditions:

- physical conditions:
  - a workplace or an environment that accurately represents workplace conditions
- resources, equipment and materials:
  - processing equipment and related services
  - · materials and consumables as required
  - · personal protective clothing and equipment
- specifications:
  - · work procedures, including advice on safe work practice
  - production schedules and specifications
- relationships:
  - · supervisor.
