Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- clarify requirements for collection of information
- collect and organise information
- analyse information and draw conclusions
- present information in appropriate formats
- use organisational technology.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- compare and contrast investigation methods
- describe the key types and sources of information to access
- describe the key features of relevant:
 - organisational policy and procedures
 - organisational products and services
 - information and communications technology
 - legislative reporting requirements.

Assessment Conditions

Assessment must be conducted in a safe environment where evidence gathered demonstrates consistent performance of typical activities experienced in the personal injury management field of work and include access to:

- office equipment, technology, software and consumables

- organisational records, policy and procedures.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
