- Silviculturalist

Entry Requirements

Packaging Rules

To be awarded the FWP20216 Certificate II in Harvesting and Haulage, competency must be achieved in **thirteen (13)** units of competency.

seven (7) core units of competency

six (6) units of competency from the elective group, consisting of:

- 2 units from Group A
- 4 units from Group A and/or Group B, the total of which can include up to 2 units recommended for packaging at Certificate I, II or III level from this or any other endorsed Training Package or state/territory accredited course.

Elective units must be relevant to work undertaken in the harvesting and haulage sector of the industry.
