Qualification Description

This qualification is designed for job roles in the wood panel products sector of the forest and forest products industry.

Job roles

This qualification has three employment pathways for typical operational environments of wood panel products. These are:

- Production Worker (Laminates)
- Production Worker (Panel and Board)
- Production Worker (Veneer)

Licensing, legislative, regulatory, or certification requirements may apply to units in this qualification in some states & territories at the time of publication and may differ according to jurisdiction.

Some imported units in the elective bank may be subject to licensing, legislative, regulatory, or certification requirements. These units must be implemented in line with the licensing requirements outlined in the unit's parent Training Package.

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements for this qualification.

Packaging Rules

To be awarded the FWP20416 Certificate II in Wood Panel Products, competency must be achieved in **thirteen (13)** units of competency.

five (5) core units of competency

eight (8) units of competency from the elective group, consisting of:

- 3 units from Group A
- 5 units from Group A and/or Group B, the total of which can include up to 2 units recommended for packaging at Certificate I, II or III level from this or any other endorsed Training Package or state/territory accredited course.

Elective units must be relevant to work undertaken in the wood panel products sector of the industry.
