Qualification Description

This qualification is designed for job roles in the timber manufactured products sector of the forest and wood products industry.

Job roles

This qualification has six employment pathways for operational environments in the forest and forest products industry. These are:

- Grader
- Manufacturing Assistant (Timber Products)
- Saw Operator
- Timber Manufacturing Worker
- Timber Products Worker
- Timber Puller

Entry Requirements

To be awarded the FWP20516 Certificate II in Timber Manufactured Products competency must be achieved in **thirteen (13)** units of competency.

- 3 units from Group A
- 5 units from Group A and/or Group B, the total of which can include up to 2 units recommended for packaging at Certificate I, II or III level from this or any other endorsed Training Package or state/territory accredited course.

Elective units must be relevant to work undertaken in the timber manufactured products sector of the industry.
