Release 1. HLTCCD006 Undertake basic clinical coding supersedes and is not equivalent to HLTADM005 Produce coded clinical data.

Application

This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills and knowledge required to assign clinical classification codes to an admitted episode of care using patient and clinical data from basic patient health care records.

This unit applies to clinical coders who are responsible for understanding and extracting patient clinical information for the purposes of clinical coding.

Determine sequencing of intervention codes according to current classification standards and conventions. 2.5. Establish sequencing of diagnoses and interventions according to the current coding standards for the episodes of care. 2.6. Use resources to assist in making coding decisions.
