Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- operate a smart card machine and produce cards for TWO different jobs according to job specifications and within the production timeframe
- demonstrate all safety devices on the smart card printing and encoding machine.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- describe operation of the card printing unit
- describe operation of the card encoding unit
- identify production quality requirements
- describe waste disposal procedures
- describe correct material handling procedures
- list principles of printing and ink usage.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the converting, binding and finishing field of work and include access to:

- smart card printing and encoding machine
- special purpose tools, equipment and materials.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
