Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- use a database requiring sophisticated variable data fields and a complex page layout with multiple static and variable elements, both text and graphics, with flexible placement
- confirm data requirements and prepare data and link it to a template ready for printing on TWO different jobs.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- describe requirements for PPML/VDX, XML
- outline key aspects of privacy legislation relating to printing data
- explain key processes involved in database operation
- explain key concepts relating to data mining.

Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the printing field of work and include access to relevant computer hardware and software.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
