## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- prepare TWO manual and electronic artworks for screen printing, according to client specifications
- apply design principles when combining elements and colour to prepare artwork, both manually and electronically, to the satisfaction of the client
- find and use task-relevant information from a variety of information sources.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

## Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- outline considerations of layout for this brief
- describe first stage of production brief
- identify most time-consuming function
- state purpose of a thumbnail
- state importance placed on detail in the first stage of the brief
- name equipment that may be used for construction of the layout
- name guides used in the design area
- outline graphic requirements included in the brief
- define how many graphic design ideas are sketched or illustrated as preliminary ideas
- list additional constraints that can be included in the concept
- explain purpose of ruling up a layout
- outline limitations of type selection on the chosen substrates
- list considerations given to elements to fit a given space
- explain use of keylines when used as element identification
- explain importance of identifying all colour(s) on rough

- outline techniques used to check for mistakes
- outline proof checks made to ensure proof conforms to the brief
- state conditions in which materials should be stored
- identify storage system used for electronic data
- identify materials that could be recycled.

## Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the Pre-Press field of work and include access to special purpose tools, equipment and industry software packages.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
