## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- develop graphics incorporating a range of features for cross-media publishing based on a client brief using a high-end application
- find and use information relevant to the task from a variety of information sources.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

## Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- describe image formats
- explain use of scripting languages
- explain how to manipulate text and apply formatting
- describe how to draw shapes
- explain how to manipulate images
- explain design principles which should be applied when creating graphics
- explain profiles
- outline considerations of colour management.

## Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the Pre-Press field of work and include access to special purpose tools, equipment and industry software packages.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
