## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- prepare a high-end Portable Document Format (PDF) file for pre-press
- locate and use information relevant to the task from a variety of information sources.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

## Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- outline work health and safety (WHS) standards that relate to working for periods of time on computers
- identify PDF printer driver options
- list driver types and preferred application
- explain suitability of a PDF writer for high-end printing
- describe true base 13 fonts

## Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the Pre-Press field of work and include access to special purpose tools, equipment and industry software packages.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
