Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to research cryptocurrency technologies, such as blockchain. It includes researching and identifying the advantages and disadvantages of industry-recognised cryptocurrency technologies in meeting organisational requirements. It also includes sourcing cryptocurrency technologies from required third-party vendors.

The unit applies to individuals who may work in a variety of entry-level cryptocurrency roles across multiple industries, including as assistants to cyber security technicians, cryptocurrency developers, analysts, traders and brokers.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of publication.

Skill	Description
Numeracy	Analyses and synthesises basic information about cryptocurrencies
Oral communication	Uses effective listening and questioning techniques and technical terminology to elicit information and make the correct component selection

Writing	Uses correct spelling, grammar and plain English together with ICT-specific terminology and diagrams to convey recommendations and requirements and complete organisational documentation
