The candidate must demonstrate the ability to complete the tasks outlined in the elements, performance criteria and foundation skills of this unit, including evidence of the ability to:

In the course of the above, the candidate must:

- analyse operating environment
- document processes and outcomes.

- critical infrastructure sectors and assets
- cyber security methodologies required to protect infrastructure for organisations
