Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to evaluate the effectiveness of organisational assistive technologies according to benchmark requirements. It includes developing an evaluation framework to analyse organisational systems, programs and software and make recommendations for improvement.

The unit applies to individuals working in information and communications technology (ICT) roles, including support technicians, user-experience researchers, inclusion officers, human resource generalists and disability access officers.
