Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to assess the digital capabilities of organisational systems to support accessibility for persons with disabilities, and trial recommended system improvements.

The unit applies to individuals working in a range of roles across all industries, including support technicians, user-experience researchers, inclusion officers, human resource generalists and disability access officers.

Foundation Skills

Skill	Description
Oral communication	- Asks questions and actively listens to gather information - Provides information during and after assessing organisational systems using a structure and language appropriate to audience
Reading	Interprets and critically analyses texts when assessing organisational systems
Writing	Uses technical vocabulary, grammatical structures and appropriate terminology in organisational documents

Skill	Description
Planning and organising	- Identifies requirements for effective communication exchanges when planning channels, formats and tone for communicating - Develops plans to manage tasks with an awareness of how they may contribute to longer term operational objectives
Technology	Demonstrates an understanding of principles, concepts, language and practices associated with the digital world and uses them to understand the uses and potential of new assistive technologies
