### Performance Evidence

Evidence of ability to:

- prepare project specifications with project objectives
- develop scope management plan
- develop scope management strategies
- conduct regular program reviews
- measure project outcomes
- manage the impact of scope changes within established budget and timeline.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

### Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- examine a range of products, services and solutions as they apply to various project outcomes
- explore various stakeholders and relevant levels of authorisation required for the duration of a project
- explain project life-cycle and the significance of scope management
- outline scope management plans, methodologies, techniques and tools
- summarise typical challenges and issues encountered in project scope management and options for addressing them
- identify and explore various project performance indicators and how project performance can be measured
- evaluate various vendor products and solutions.

## Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances should be typical of those experienced in the telecommunications networks engineering field of work and include access to:

- sites on which projects may be conducted
- forecast data and tools involved in planning
- a range of software and hardware currently used in industry
- relevant regulations and specifications that impact forecasting activities.

Assessors of this unit must satisfy the requirements for assessors in applicable vocational education and training legislation, frameworks and/or standards.
