## Performance Evidence

Evidence of the ability to:

- analyse the client's needs
- undertake research to source the images
- manipulate and produce images for use in website development, to meet the requirements of the brief
- save the images in appropriate format.

Note: If a specific volume or frequency is not stated, then evidence must be provided at least once.

## Knowledge Evidence

To complete the unit requirements safely and effectively, the individual must:

- identify and describe, the industry standards and the copyright legislation relevant to digital images
- explain sustainability concepts appropriate to the ICT industry
- describe digital image formats and their application
- identify and summarise, common digital image editing software.

## Assessment Conditions

Gather evidence to demonstrate consistent performance in conditions that are safe and replicate the workplace. Noise levels, production flow, interruptions and time variances must be typical of those experienced in the website technologies field of work, and include access to:

- image manipulation software, hardware and storage devices currently used in industry
- the client brief

- the sources of the images, and opportunities to review digital images prepared for a website
- the organisational policy and procedures.

Assessors must satisfy NVR/AQTF assessor requirements.
