Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to implement mobile-user functions to websites and maintain website user experience on mobile devices. It involves optimising the functionality and accessibility of websites for mobile devices.

The unit applies to individuals who may work in roles such as website developers and technical support staff, who support the management and useability of simple websites.

Periodically review mobile website functionality	4.1 Create periodic website testing plan and timelines 4.2 Test and debug mobile features according to work brief 4.3 Deploy website on mobile device and rectify any deployment issues 4.4 Seek and integrate feedback from required personnel on testing and debugging process 4.5 Document maintenance changes according to organisational policies and procedures

Foundation Skills
