Tasks include:	•	answering telephone inquiries

- answering telephone inquiries
- assist in docking, securing and casting-off vessels
- berth allocation considering vessel lengths, beams and drafts
- communicating with customers through email
- dock walks and inspection of public areas on a marina
- minor landscaping and gardening work •
- rope work, knot tying and splicing including maintenance and storage of ropes
- rubbish removal and general housekeeping
