Performance Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence in this unit must be relevant to and satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria on at least one occasion and include:

- following manufacturer recommendations, regulations and vessel operating procedures
- implementing safe work practices
- using deck machinery.

Knowledge Evidence

Evidence required to demonstrate competence in this unit must be relevant to and satisfy all of the requirements of the elements and performance criteria and include knowledge of:

- basic hydraulic systems and their operation
- · legislation affecting lifting equipment
- lifting equipment
- · own ability and limits to rectify irregularities and faults
- safe working procedures
- trawling and fishing gear
- · winches, capstans, windlasses
- work health and safety (WHS)/occupational health and safety (OHS) requirements and work practices.

Assessment Conditions

Assessors must satisfy National Vocational Education and Training Regulator (NVR)/Australian Quality Training Framework (AQTF) assessor requirements.

Assessment must occur in workplace operational situations where it is appropriate to do so; where this is not appropriate, assessment must occur in simulated workplace operational situations that reflect workplace conditions.

Assessment processes and techniques must be appropriate to the language, literacy and numeracy requirements of the work being performed and the needs of the candidate.

Resources for assessment must include access to:

- tools, equipment, machinery, materials currently used in industry
- personal protective equipment including:
 - boots
 - gloves
 - hard hat
 - hearing protection
 - overalls
 - protective eyewear
- applicable documentation such as legislation, regulations, codes of practice, workplace procedures and operational manuals
- range of relevant exercises, case studies and/or simulations.
