Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to plan deployed aircraft maintenance, provide support to deployed maintenance personnel, and monitor and evaluate their activities within the Australian Defence Force (ADF) airworthiness jurisdiction. Work may be performed individually or as part of a team.

The unit applies to deployment and detachment activities at away-from-home bases of aircraft that are to be supported by a deployed maintenance team for scheduled and unscheduled maintenance. The work may be undertaken in Australia or overseas in military airfields, civilian airfields, and unprepared areas of operations.

The unit is used in workplaces that operate under the airworthiness regulatory systems of the Defence Aviation Safety Authority (DASA).

Any other relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Foundation Skills
