Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to manage the custody, transfer and disposal of aircraft, aeronautical product and support equipment, including test equipment and ground support equipment, used in scheduled and unscheduled maintenance. It involves applying required regulatory and organisational procedures in the course of activities. Work may be performed individually or as part of a team.

The unit is used in workplaces that operate under the airworthiness regulatory systems of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) and the Defence Aviation Safety Authority (DASA).

Any other relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
