Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to apply hand skills to remove and install electrical and electronic system components while overhauling aircraft seats and pods and using basic electrical test equipment and in-flight entertainment system test sets to perform functional tests and confirm system serviceability. Work may be done during scheduled or unscheduled maintenance, and individually or as part of a team.

The unit is used in workplaces that operate under the airworthiness regulatory systems of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) and the Defence Aviation Safety Authority (DASA).

Any other relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.
