Application

This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to apply sealant to the surface seams of aircraft and aircraft components prior to surface coating application on fixed and rotary wing aircraft and aircraft components during the performance of scheduled or unscheduled maintenance. Work may be performed individually or as part of a team.

The unit is used in workplaces that operate under the airworthiness regulatory systems of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) and the Defence Aviation Safety Authority (DASA).

Any other relevant legislation, industry standards and codes of practice within Australia must be applied.

Apply sealant to seams	4.1 Apply sealant in accordance with enterprise procedures or process specifications while observing all relevant WHS requirements, including the use of MSDS and items of PPE 4.2 Inspect sealed seam and fill blemishes, voids or gaps in accordance with standard enterprise procedures 4.3 Remove masking materials are removed in accordance with standard enterprise procedures 4.4 Dispose of waste or surplus materials in accordance with legislative, regulatory and enterprise procedures 4.5 Complete documentation in accordance with standard enterprise procedures 4.6 Leave aircraft or component, equipment and work area in suitable condition for next task in accordance with standard enterprise procedures
