 - racks
 - helical gears
 - radial uniform rise cam lobes

Milling cutter/cutters include one (1) or more of the following:

- ganged cutters
- form cutters

Set up includes the following:

- verifying using instruments, including dial test indicators and sine bars

Appropriate accessories include the following:

- omniversal tables
- differential dividing heads
