This unit of competency defines the skills and knowledge required to plan and apply casting techniques for constructing jewellery and object designs. It includes the use of wax models and moulds and application of metal casting skills.

This unit applies to individuals involved in jewellery or object design or manufacture in a small or large-scale production context. They use and adapt creative and technical skills and knowledge to produce work.
