Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- installed 1 type of sprung timber sports floor as part of a team in accordance with job requirements, demonstrating a minimum of 20m² as the lead installer for the:
 - subfloor system
 - flooring installation.
 -

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- sprung timber sports flooring installation:
 - Australian Standards requirements
 - workplace safety system requirements
 - environmental protection and sustainability requirements
 - manufacturer recommendations
 - work flow in relation to flooring installation operations
 - mathematical procedures for estimation and measurement
 - characteristics and requirements of subfloor preparation
 - types, characteristics, uses and limitations of sprung timber sports flooring, including:
 - strip tongue and groove
 - parquet floating floors
 - manufactured engineered flooring used for indoor sporting applications
 - types, characteristics, uses and limitations of installation adhesives, including:
 - polyvinyl alcohol (PVA)
 - polyurethane elastomeric
 - uses, characteristics, and limitations of rubber and neoprene underfloor pads
 - types, characteristics, safe use, maintenance and limitations of tools, equipment and materials
 - techniques for set out, cutting and laying, the types of problems that may occur and how to avoid and respond
 - basic wood working techniques

- quality indicators for completed work
- procedures for the recording, reporting and maintenance of workplace records and information.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies.

The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of suitable facilities, equipment and resources, including:
 - locations requiring installation of sprung timber floors
 - sprung timber flooring materials
 - equipment, tools and materials to complete tasks in the Performance Evidence, including safety and personal protective equipment
 - work orders
 - workplace procedures.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
