 - 1 pre-finished engineered flooring
- implemented 1 of the above maintenance systems.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- mathematical procedures for estimation and calculation maintenance and repair costing within budgetary guidelines
- flooring maintenance planning:
 - Australian Standards requirements
 - types of maintenance requirements
 - environmental protection and sustainability requirements
 - manufacturer recommendations
 - information to be evaluated
 - resource implications
 - methods and process for planning
 - communication
 - implementation scheduling.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of suitable facilities, equipment and resources, including:
 - floors requiring maintenance schedules.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
