Conduct glass mirroring operations	3.1 Apply tinning solution in accordance with workplace procedures 3.2 Rinse glass with demineralised water in accordance with workplace procedures 3.3 Apply mirror solution to glass in accordance with workplace procedures 3.4 Wash and blow dry glass in accordance with workplace procedures 3.5 Apply backing paint in accordance with workplace procedures
4. Complete work	4.1 Inspect product for quality of work and discard or return items which do not meet quality requirements for reprocessing in accordance with workplace procedures 4.2 Place completed work in holding area in accordance with workplace procedures 4.3 Clean work area and safely dispose of rubbish in accordance with workplace procedures 4.4 Inspect, maintain and tag equipment in accordance with workplace procedures 4.5 Remove and store tools, equipment and unused materials in accordance with workplace procedures 4.6 Accurately complete required workplace documentation
