Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- analysed, developed and maintained at least 2 workplace documents, where 1 must be a workplace procedure, in response to identified information requirements or changes in laboratory policy or external accreditation requirements, including:
 - · obtaining and incorporating feedback on draft documentation
 - using internal and external information sources efficiently
 - producing documentation that is accurate and meets specifications, free from editorial errors and omissions, and understood by others.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- how work health and safety (WHS), environmental, registration/accreditation and other legislative requirements, regulations and codes govern laboratory documentation
- · workplace procedures relevant to the laboratory's operations and scope of testing
- scientific, technical and workplace terminology
- technical developments in the sector, including current methodologies, interpretations and any changes that may require document review
- registration/licensing and/or accreditation requirements
- workplace procedures for developing and/or amending and tracking documentation
- records management and maintenance
- workplace communication protocols and reporting.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of suitable facilities, equipment and resources, including:
 - document control system

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• workplace documents and procedures.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
