## MSM21122 Certificate II in Recreational Vehicle Trade Pathways

### Modification History

Release 1. Supersedes and is not equivalent to MSM21115 Certificate II in Recreational Vehicle Manufacturing and MSM21015 Certificate II in Recreational Vehicle Service and Repair. Number of units required reduced to 7. Changes to core units and core unit requirement increased and electives removed, to better reflect job role requirements. Workplace outcome has changed.

### Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the role of an entry-level worker in the recreational vehicle industry who performs basic, defined work tasks under supervision involving known routines and procedures. The qualification is typically used to develop basic employment-related skills and knowledge.

No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.
