Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

• identified, prioritised, organised and implemented work activities to meet requirements of procedures and work instructions on at least 1 occasion

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- sources of information about allocated work activities, procedures, timelines, schedules and work priorities
- methods for identifying steps and components of work activities to prioritise and implement
- · routine problems, their probable causes and relevant corrective actions
- organisation procedures relevant to the work environment and job role.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies, as well as, using suitable facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
