Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

 identified the social sustainability implications of systems, procedures and work practices for at least 1 organisation and promoted and implemented changes to improve social sustainability.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- social sustainability issues that may affect the work area or work group
- current industry practices to address social sustainability issues
- · legislative and regulatory requirements that have social sustainability implications
- voluntary codes and standards that have social sustainability implications
- the organisation's processes for implementing initiatives, amending procedures, making recommendations and reporting
- procedures that support participation
- change management strategies
- factors that contribute to lack of engagement, discrimination and poor participation in the workplace
- approaches to measuring social sustainability.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
