This unit describes the skills and knowledge required to develop and implement an optimisation plan for sustainability performance of a work area or process.

This unit applies to team leaders, managers or others who have been given the responsibility to implement improvements to systems and practices to improve performance and compliance in sustainability. The individual will identify current areas of suboptimal performance, determine probable causes and develop and implement an optimisation plan using a continuous improvement approach.

This unit applies to any organisation.

Foundation Skills

This section describes those language, literacy, numeracy and employment skills that are essential to performance but not explicit in the performance criteria.

- Writing skills to document optimisation plan, recommendations, workplace documentation and continuous improvement strategies
- Oral communication skills to communicate with a range of stakeholders on improvement options
- Numeracy skills to determine areas for performance improvements and measurable objectives
- Learning skills to identify and interpret information about approaches to sustainability.

Other foundation skills essential to performance are explicit in the performance criteria of this unit.
