Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- developed at least 1 strategic sustainability plan to improve one or more of the following:
 - products
 - processes
 - employee, health, safety and environment (HSE) or amenity
 - impact on the community
 - impact on the environment
 - energy use
 - greenhouse gas reduction
 - efficiency and profit
 - waste management
 - emergency and incident response
 - facility or building design and management.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- strategic directions of the organisation
- strategic planning tools, including strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, threats (SWOT) analysis
- strategic approvals for implementation
- sustainability status of organisation
- sustainability indicators
- methods of identifying sustainability improvements
- risk analysis
- cost-benefit analysis
- planning principles
- evaluation methods
- AS/NZS ISO 14001 Environmental Management Systems or its authorised replacement
- sustainability codes, schemes, legislation and regulation.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
