Performance Evidence

- methods of determining benefits of sustainability improvement projects
- causes of resistance and methods of dealing with resistance
- sources of data
- data validation techniques
- techniques to analyse data for trends, aberrations and factors requiring action
- project planning and monitoring
- improvement measures
- AS/NZS ISO 14001 Environmental Management Systems or its authorised replacement.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions and contingencies. The following conditions must be met for this unit:

- use of facilities, equipment and resources, including:
 - sustainability plan.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
