Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

• informed and educated at least 2 groups on sustainability issues.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- sustainability principles
- value chain concepts
- sustainability issues, including climate change, carbon pollution, waste generation and control
- principles of energy and water conservation
- precautionary principle
- sustainability and environmental legal context
- principles of biological and ecological diversity
- methods of interpreting and presenting data
- sources of data and information in own organisation and from public sources
- AS/NZS ISO 14001 Environmental Management Systems or its authorised replacement.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
