Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- social sustainability issues
- purpose and benefits of monitoring social sustainability for organisation
- legislative, regulatory requirements that have social sustainability implications
- voluntary codes and standards that have social sustainability implications
- current industry practices, approaches, metrics and indicators that relate to social sustainability, including social return on investment, social license to operate, corporate social responsibility, human capital and shared value
- methods of quantification and quantitative estimating
- the limitations of using proxies and indicators and estimations to quantify social sustainability
- stakeholder engagement techniques
- methods and tools for collecting social sustainability data.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
