Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- identified and responded to external sustainability factors relevant to at least 1 organisation or part of an organisation.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- process and changes which occur at each step in selected value chain
- principles of sustainability
- current actual and possible sources of external sustainability factors relevant to the organisation
- possible responses for improving sustainability
- root cause analysis
- sustainability legislation, regulation and protocols, government incentives and initiatives
- risk analysis and its application to sustainability risks
- hierarchy of hazard control and its application to sustainability hazards.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
