Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- identified sustainability related interactions with the community for at least 1 organisation and all or part of the value chain and defined and analysed impact of the interactions, including:
 - developing and implementing at least 1 solution targeting reduced adverse impacts and improved interactions.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- process and changes which occur at each step in selected value chain
- principles of sustainability
- causes of adverse ecological, social, economic impacts and methods of controlling or reducing them
- root cause analysis
- risk assessment and hierarchy of control and its application to sustainability hazards and risks
- sustainability hierarchy
- · sustainability legislation, regulation and protocols, government incentives and initiatives
- sustainability interactions with community
- community benefits offered by the organisation or its value chain.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
