Performance Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has completed the tasks outlined in the elements and performance criteria of this unit, and:

- facilitated the development, documentation and evaluation of at least 1 social sustainability strategy across the whole or part of an organisation.

Knowledge Evidence

There must be evidence the candidate has knowledge of:

- purpose of social sustainability strategy
- social sustainability issues, practices and approaches in the organisation and its value chain that may provide strategic opportunities for the business
- stakeholders and their roles in the organisation
- strategies for equitable stakeholder participation
- strategic analysis and planning techniques
- processes for risk management
- processes for planning and managing change
- legislative and regulatory requirements that have social sustainability implications
- voluntary codes and standards that have social sustainability implications including Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) reporting and ISO 26000:2010 Guidance on social responsibility or equivalent.

Assessment Conditions

Skills must have been demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment that reflects workplace conditions, contingencies, facilities, equipment and resources.

Assessors must satisfy the NVR/AQTF mandatory competency requirements for assessors.
